Walmart does not offer grants to any 501(c)(19) qualified charity. You have to be a 501(c)(3) charity to qualify for a Walmart grant. (Tommy Jones).

We qualify for a JB Hunt Charity Giving grant. However, JB Hunt only accepts requests during December of each year....we will focus on grant proposal completion by Sept with revisions ready by Dec.

Tysons Foods has a quarterly charity application cycle. The next quarter applications are due by April 26, 2024 with approvals communicated on May 31, 2024. If an application is not approved in the quarter it was submitted, it remains active for the two subsequent quarters. However, according to their Corporate Giving Program Guidelines, we need to have a 501(c)(3) tax-status and the minimum grant amount is \$5,000..... do we need to change?

Below is the Flag Program Director's and Treasurer's Report for April 2024 for Tuesday's meeting:

- 1. Chapter Name Change. We received the formal Articles of Amendment on April 8, 2024, from the Arkansas Secretary of State that changes our Chapter name to Ozark Regional Chapter. On April 8, 2024, I emailed, along with a copy of the Articles of Amendment, national MOAA to change our Chapter name on their website. I also sent a letter on April 8, 2024, to the Arkansas Council of Chapters to do the same for their website. National MOAA and the Arkansas Council of Chapters has yet to update our Chapter name on their respective websites.
- 2. State Sponsorship of the US Flag Education Program. On the Arkansas Department of Veterans Affairs (ADVA) website, there is a tab at the top for Veterans Services. Clicking on Veterans Services reveals a dropdown menu that includes an entry titled Flag Education Program. The results of the five recommendations made to Ms. Duke in January are unknown as they have not appeared yet on the ADVA Flag Education Program website.
- 3. Arkansas US Flag Education Program Presentations.
- a. As of March 16th, we have delivered, or have a firm commitment to deliver, the Arkansas US Flag Education Program to fifth graders at all 37 contacted schools in Benton County AR and McDonald County MO. To date, we have taught, scheduled, and remain to be scheduled the following number of students:

Taught: 3,037
 Scheduled: 1,533
 To Be Scheduled: 0
 Total 4,570

- b. Through the Bella Vista Honor Guard, we were put in touch with Grimsley Junior High School in Bentonville. We met with a Social Studies teacher on April 10th and have agreed to present to their seventh grade students on May 1st and 2nd, and and their eighth grade students on May 15th and 16th. They have a total of 900 seventh and eight grade students.
- c. We have a Google Calendar linked to the Events Calendar on our Chapter website. Flag presentation information is being populated on this calendar in the event any Chapter members wish to attend a specific school's presentation.
- 4. Arvest Account Balances as of April 22, 2024:

• Non-interest Checking: \$ 735.11

• Money Market: \$1,637.42

• Total \$2,372.53

There have been no expenses for April 2024. We collected \$120.00 in annual Chapter dues last month.

- 5. Now that we have received official approval of our name change from the Office of the Arkansas Secretary of State, we need to update the name on our non-interest checking account and money market account at Arvest Bank, and order checks with the new Chapter name and address.
- 6. I have the business cards to distribute at tomorrow's meeting. If you ordered 50 cards, the cost is \$9.25, and for 100 cards, the cost is \$18.50. The shirts have been ordered and the Chapter logo approved. We do not have a date yet for delivery.
